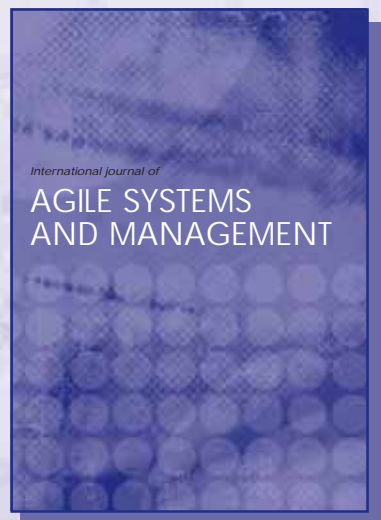


Scope of the Journal
