

Klassische Philharmonie Bonn – Orchestra

The Klassische Philharmonie Bonn is the orchestra which followed the Chur Coelnisches Orchester in Bonn, which Heribert Beissel founded in 1959. The idea behind this was to bring the music of the Chur Coelnische Court in Bonn to light. At present, the stylistic development has led the orchestra to perform also works of the „Wiener Klassik“ now as its main repertoire. The successful series of concerts are now in the following cities in Germany: Hamburg, Bremen, Hannover, Berlin, Bielefeld, Bonn, Wiesbaden, Karlsruhe, Stuttgart, Nürnberg and München.

The orchestra has, as a central purpose, to give young orchestra musicians and soloists the opportunity to perform in these cities. The city of Bonn supports the orchestra. Heribert Beissel is its principal conductor.

The Klassische Philharmonie Bonn has had concert tours in Spain, Italy, France, Belgium, Holland, England, Japan and the USA. Also the orchestra has performed in festivals in Gran Canaria, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, Schweswig-Holstein, Bregenz, the Flanders Festival, International Bach Woche in Ansbach, Music Festival Weeks in Schloss Kammer, the Salzburg Castle Concerts and the Summer Concerts between Donau and Altmuehtal.
